

Directory Listing Options

CenturyLink offers several options for how your telephone number is listed in our directories. You can ask to have your name removed, at no charge, from lists that we lease to other firms. Non-Listed and Non-Published telephone numbers are automatically excluded from the lists we lease.

Main Listing

The main listing that comes with your telephone number includes your last name, first name, and middle name or initial, along with your street address, community, and telephone number.

When you decide how you want your listing to read, you can:

- Replace your first name and/or middle name with initials.
- Omit the community name and/or street address from your listing.
- Have a "dual surname" listing. This allows people with different last names, living at the same address, to have both names shown in their listing. Just tell us which last name you want to appear first for the alphabetical sequence of the listing.

Applicable charges: There's no charge for choosing these options when you create your listing, however, a setup charge will apply for listing changes on existing service.

Non-Listed (Semi-Private)

If you ask for this type of listing, your name, address and phone number aren't shown in the printed telephone directory. Your name and telephone number will be available through Directory Assistance.

Applicable charges: Monthly

Non-Published (Private)

If you ask for this type of listing, your name, address, and phone number will not appear in the directory and are not available through Directory Assistance.

Applicable charges: Monthly
One-time setup fee

No Solicitation Listing

A black dot (●) will appear in the printed directory next to your telephone number. This indicates you do not wish to receive solicitation calls or mail.

Applicable charges: Monthly
