

Speed Calling 8

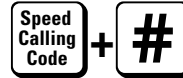
Dialing your most frequently called numbers is fast and easy with Speed Calling 8. Simply make a list of the eight numbers you want to program, and assign each one a single-digit code from 2 to 9.

To program



Then enter a one-digit code + phone number, including any necessary area code or access code. Example: To program phone number 602-555-1234, press ***74** + Code **2** + area code **602** + 7 digits **555-1234**

To dial



Example: Code **2** + **#** dials 602-555-1234

How to use Speed Calling 8

- Make a list of your eight most important or frequently dialed numbers.
- Assign each a one-digit code from 2 to 9.
- Lift the receiver and press ***74**.
- Press the one-digit code you've selected, followed by the telephone number assigned to that code.
Include your access code and/or area code if it's a long-distance number.
- You'll hear a tone to let you know the number is programmed.
- Repeat these steps for the other seven numbers.

To call someone on your Speed Calling list

- Press the code (2-9) you gave to that person, followed by the **#** key.

To change a programmed number

- Repeat the first 5 steps above. You don't need to reprogram the numbers you want to keep.

For Rotary Phones

If you are using a rotary telephone instead of a touch-tone, dial ①①⑦④ (instead of ***74**), then dial the code you gave to the number you want to call, without the **#**. The phone will hesitate a moment, then dial the number.

Speed Calling 30 gives you more.

If you find you have more than eight important numbers you want to program, you may want to try Speed Calling 30 instead. Speed Calling 30 easily adds thirty numbers to your speed dialing list!
